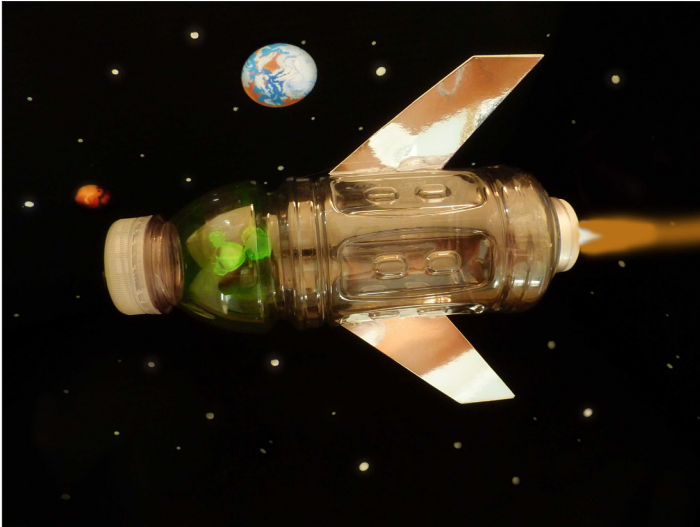
Cut along dotted line to create a wings.

## Items you will need to complete this project

- Empty Gatorade bottle
- 1 piece of 8 1/2 X 11" card-stock (preferably in shiny silver or white).
- Silver Bottom cut from an empty soda pop can. Scissors will work.
- Empty aluminum tea lite
- Battery-operated tea lite
- Hot glue gun
- Scissors
- Optional plastic Alien creatures from a gumball machine.

## Directions

1. Wash an empty Gatorade bottle with warm sudsy water. Screw the plastic cap back on.
2. Download and print out the wing templates.
3. Trace the wing templates onto silver card-stock paper and cut them out.
4. With a hot glue gun, glue the 2 two wings to either side of the empty Gatorade bottle.
5. Hot glue the bottom of the soda can (as shown in the photo) to the bottom of the Gatorade bottle.
6. Next, glue the empty aluminum Tea-lite candle onto the bottom of the soda can.
7. Turn on the flame and place the battery operated Tea-lite into the empty aluminum Tea-lite candle. You may need to roll a piece of tape to hold it in place.

VOILA! You now have yourself a whip-zinger, super-sonic spaceship. Grab a buddy and soar through the universe.

**Idea:** for a background, paint the inside of an cardboard box black. Paint white dots for stars, and tape the moon and earth images in place (included with these instructions).
